Sam Relief, Inc. is an all-volunteer non-profit 501(c)(3) Organization dedicated to providing educational resources to the impoverished children of Cambodia.

Sam Relief donates 100% of its proceeds to build schools and construct fresh water wells. In addition, Sam Relief provides Cambodian children and their families necessities such as rice, rice seed, farm equipment, medicine, school supplies, eyeglasses, and school uniforms.



We also repair dilapidated schools, subsidize teachers' salaries and provide scholarships for high school students to attend University. Recently Sam Relief created a Food for Work program in Cambodia which hires adults to work on local projects such as creating roads and dikes for the poorest rural communities.



we are planning to build a five classrooms school at Preah Vihear Province for 2012 or 2013.

Since the inception of Sam Relief, Inc. in 1999, we have built 24 new schools, dug 320 new wells, donated 220 tons of rice to teachers, Children's Hospital of Cambodia, and others in need and have awarded 101 scholarships.



Students no longer travel barefoot to and from school with our provision of flip flops.
